Maintenance

Minimal maintenance is required. These tiles do not require sealing. Porcelain's dense surface absorbs very little moisture, so spills that might seep into another material and cause a stain, can easily be wiped up with a damp cloth or hosed off. Jupiter generally only needs to be swept and cleaned with water and a mild detergent regularly. It is the perfect material for those who want a quality natural stone look with very little effort.

Porcelain tiles do not need sealing due to having little to no porosity. However, some people choose to seal their porcelain, as there is no doubt it makes cleaning easier. Sealing will especially assist with the cleaning of the grout. After sealing their porcelain, some customers have told us that they even vacuum their tiles!! Please ensure you use an appropriate 'porcelain specific' penetrating sealer. We recommend seeking assistance from John from Stone Clean and Seal for advice.

Slip Rating (Wet Pendulum)

This tile has a P5 slip rating in the (V) pendulum classification which is the highest wet pendulum rating available under the current standards. (For pool surrounds, a minimum of P4 is required.)
